#### **I. CHURCH & COMMUNITY AFFAIRS**

##### **B. FISH (For I Shall Help)**

Barrington FISH is a network of local volunteers who answer the transportation needs of the community, when family, friends or public transportation are not available. The majority of clients are elderly local residents, who are grateful to have a ride to a doctor or therapy. There are three types of volunteers: (1) the driver volunteer (a pre-assigned day), (2) the telephone volunteer (once a month – need access to phone or cell), and (3) the substitute driver (called when needed). Saint Anne provides the most volunteers and is the backbone of FISH, and volunteers are always needed.
