

SAINT ANNE CHILDREN'S FAITH FORMATION

Missed Session Planning Guide - Sunday

Even the most diligent family will miss a session now and again for a variety of reasons. Making up the session provides you the opportunity to be your child's catechist, sharing the gift of faith with them as you deepen your own faith. As you answer this call, know that the Holy Spirit will inspire and guide you along the way!

There are two distinct parts to a Sunday Children's Faith Formation session:

- Scripture Reflection & Prayer – *if your child missed Children's Liturgy during Mass*
- Session content from your child's ***Finding God*** book – *if your child missed their Children's Faith Formation session at 10:15 a.m.*

When a *Finding God* session or Children's Liturgy of the Word is missed, all missed parts should be made up in order for the absence to be excused. Even if you miss more than one session, you should commit to making up **only one session per week**; otherwise it is too much information for your child to absorb.

SETTING THE STAGE FOR YOUR TIME TOGETHER

Gather a pencil, a Scripture Reflection & Prayer sheet, the scripture reflection for the day, and/or your child's *Finding God* book, and any other items you may need for activities you may have planned to do to accompany the session.

If you are able, set up a prayer table which can be as simple as placing a Bible and a candle on a table near you, or you can make it more elaborate by adding a plant or flowers, a cross or other religious symbol, and a cloth on the table in the liturgical color for the day. To check the day's liturgical color, go to the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishop's web site, www.usccb.org, and the Daily Readings calendar on the right side will show the day's color in the box for that date. Ask your child to help create this table.

FINDING GOD SESSION CONTENT – IF YOUR CHILD MISSED CHILDREN’S FAITH FORMATION

Please use the Children’s Faith Formation calendar to guide you to the proper Session to cover for the week missed.

After reviewing the chapter yourself, sit down with your child and teach and discuss the workbook session content and complete the activities together. Allow your child to complete the Reflect portion of the lesson on their own before discussing as this section helps the child to internalize what has been learned.

SCRIPTURE READING AND REFLECTION – IF YOUR CHILD MISSED CHILDREN’S LITURGY OF THE WORD

Begin with the scripture reflection which includes some information on the reading along with discussion questions. This is a good opportunity to help your child learn how to look up scripture in the Bible (see instructions in **Navigating the Bible**). If you don’t have access to a Bible, go to www.usccb.org and look up the reading in the Books of the Bible section of that website.

First, read the scripture together and share in the reflection. There are several reflection questions provided so that if your child does not connect with one, there are others that may help spark thought. The goal is a meaningful discussion, not a response to each and every question. When your discussion concludes, ask your child to take a few minutes to write what they heard and thought on the **Scripture Reflection Response & Prayers** sheet in the area that begins with **“Today I heard the Word of God and...”**

PRAYER – IF YOUR CHILD MISSED CHILDREN’S LITURGY OF THE WORD

The focus here is two-fold, one to learn to pray and the other to learn prayers. Learning to pray allows the children to think about the needs of others along with their own needs, similar to the intercessions offered at Mass. They are encouraged to think about people in need of prayer and to offer their prayers to God, both during their time with you and, hopefully, every other day on their own. Prayers can be written on the **Scripture Reflection Response & Prayer** sheet in the area that begins with **“My heart tells me to pray for...”**

There are also prayers to be learned at each grade level which are outlined below in the **Prayer List by Grade** section. Ask your child which prayer they are working on in their group. This is a perfect way to conclude your time together by saying the prayer aloud. Repetition is, of course, the most effective way to learn prayers. Try to incorporate those already learned to aid retention.

RETURNING YOUR SCRIPTURE REFLECTION RESPONSE & PRAYER SHEET AND FINDING GOD QUIZ

Scripture Reflection Response & Prayer Sheet - please be sure to write your child's full name, grade and the title of the reflection. Without this information, we have no way to know who it is from and which week the sheet belongs with.

Return the Scripture Reflection and Prayer sheet in any of the following ways:

- Scan or photograph the document(s) and email them, putting your child's full name in the subject line, to StAnneFaithFormation@stannebarrington.org
- Turn them in to the Children's Faith Formation office in the school building the next time you are with your group at Saint Anne
- In the church building, drop it in the Faith Formation basket under the missal table to the right of the worship space doors as you enter
- Bring it to the Faith Formation or Rectory office in the Parish Center

Finding God Workbook - after completion of the **Finding God** session activities, your child should then complete the **Interactive Session Review** as follows:

- Go to: www.LoyolaPress.com
- Choose **Faith Formation**
- Under Faith Formation Programs for Grades K-8 choose **Finding God**
- Click on the orange banner for **Finding God 2013**
- Choose **Family Resources**
- Select your child's grade level, scroll past the At-Home Edition to the grade-level resources, choose the missed session number, complete the **Interactive Session Review**
- **After completing the online review, please return the results as follows:**
 - **"To" E-mail Address:** - the system can send to up to two email addresses, therefore please address to yourself and Saint Anne Faith Formation as follows **using a comma and no space:**
youraddress@xxx.xx,stannefaithformation@stannebarrington.org
 - **"From" (first and last name):** include both the **first and last name of the child**
 - **If you do not receive the confirmation email,** it likely means that we did not either. Please let us know that a situation occurred and ask your child to take the quiz again, following the above procedures. Perhaps wait a while before the second try in the hope that the glitch will work itself out.
